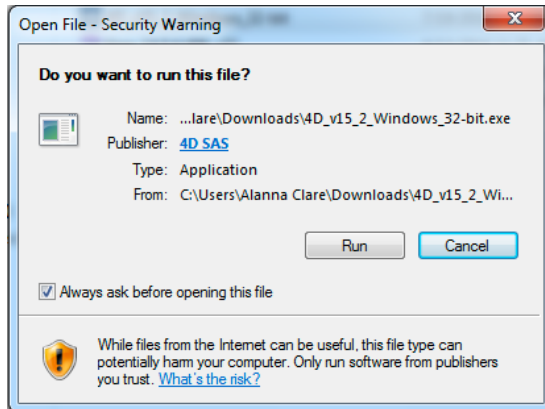
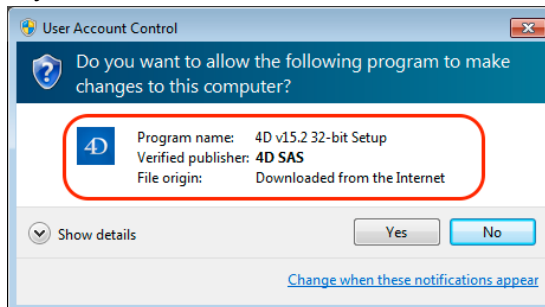


# How to Install 4D - Windows

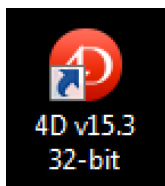
1. Go to [http://tools.portagebay.com/clients/ceradyne\\_3m.html](http://tools.portagebay.com/clients/ceradyne_3m.html) and select the link for 4D installer for Windows; when the file download window opens, select Save.
2. Make a note of the location listed in the dialog box so you can find it when the download is complete.
3. Installation
  - a. Find the file named “4D\_v15\_3\_Windows\_32-bit.exe” and double click on it. You may get a message asking if you want to run the file. If so, select “Run.”



- b. If asked if you want to allow the program to make changes to your computer, verify that it says 4D and select Yes or Allow.



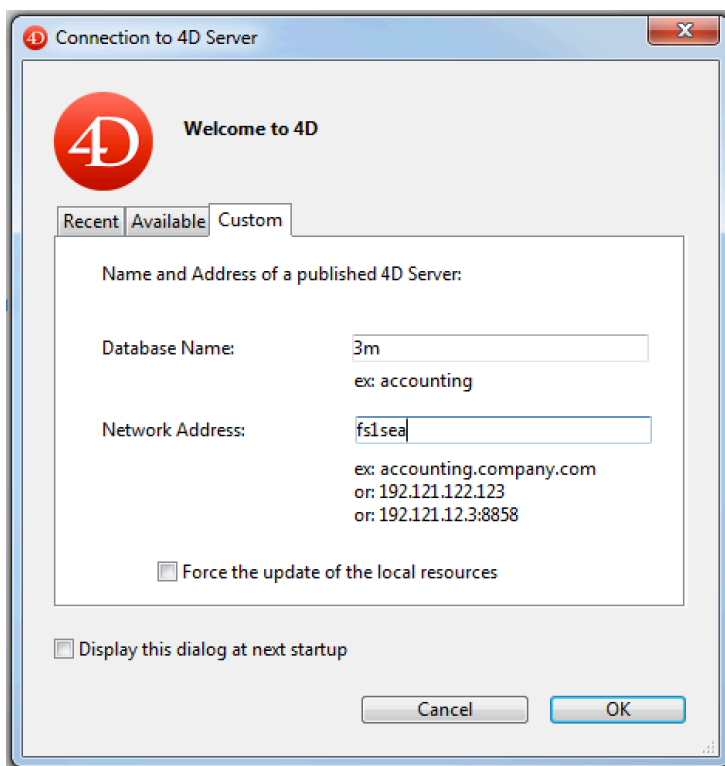
- c. The Setup Wizard will open. Click Next.
  - d. If you wish a language in addition to English, select that from the list. Otherwise, just select “Next”.
  - e. Leave the location as is and click Next.
  - f. Allow for a desktop icon and a quick launch icon, and click Next.
  - g. Click Install.
  - h. Click Finish once installation is complete.
4. You should have a red 4D 15.3 icon on your desktop. Double-click on this icon.



- When 4D opens, there should be a large splash screen (Welcome Wizard). Select “Launching Applications” and then “Connect to 4D Server.”



- In the Connection window that comes up, select the “Custom” tab and enter 3m as the database name and fs1sea as the network address.



- Click OK. Allow the files to synchronize (this should only happen the first time)
- Log in as usual.
- The next time you wish to log into 4D, simply double-click the 4D desktop icon, and when 4D opens, select “Open recent” under the Open icon on the top menu bar. Double click on 3m and log in.
